

The first aspect concentrated on the curriculum design and its applicability teachers responded strongly agreed with 12.5% and agree ticked with 75% rating. The rating on the effectiveness of admission process was lower compared to last year 69%. Some teachers found to be not satisfied over the aspect related with fair work distribution and assignment the rating was 69%. There isimprovement on the question based on library and the rating was 88% rating was given. 81% rating was received over the question about the encouragement of the college to organize seminars, workshops, conferences and carry out research publication and paper presentation shows improvement. And rating of 81% over the encouragement of the college to participate in seminars, workshops, conferences and carry out research publication and paper presentation. The rating over the question on teaching aids and support of adequate learning resources was 56% need to improve quality and quantity of resources. The rating was mearly 57% over the aspect about the encouragement to undertake extension service programmes. The teachers were agreed over the question related with the recognition of the merit with 82% rating. The aspects of examination and evaluation system, teachers were agreed with 88% ratings. Some questions on infrastructure were framed. Adequacy of the classrooms and furniture were rated strongly agreed 37% and agreed 44% whereas the no. of toilets was rated sufficient with 62% rating. The rating of the question over the optimum use of available college infrastructure was 71% teachers agreed shows improvement than previous year. According to teachers, the sports facilities were adequate 56% rating was given needed to be improve. Over the aspects of college administration, the rating of the teachers was good. The rating of accessibility of college administration was strongly agreed by 88%. The rating was 87% over the question on the regular meeting of the staff for smooth functioning of the college; teachers seemed to be strongly agreed over the question on the freedom of expression in the management meeting with 25% and agree with 63% rating. The rating of the implementation of the suggestions was on the higher side with 88%

rating. Teachers were satisfied over the aspect of providing adequate opportunities and support to them by the college with 100% rating.

There were few suggestions:

- 1. More no. of laboratory equipments, furniture, library books and computers and printers are needed
- 2. Need to encourage faculty members to attend seminar workshops and conferences
- 3. The students of every batch need to permit to visit industry of their choice relevant to their curriculum.
- 4. Students need to encourage visiting library for sports in their leisure time.

This brief report on teacher's feedback is now forwarding to the academic council for further progress in the fulfillment of the requirements and also to take necessary action on suggestions.
